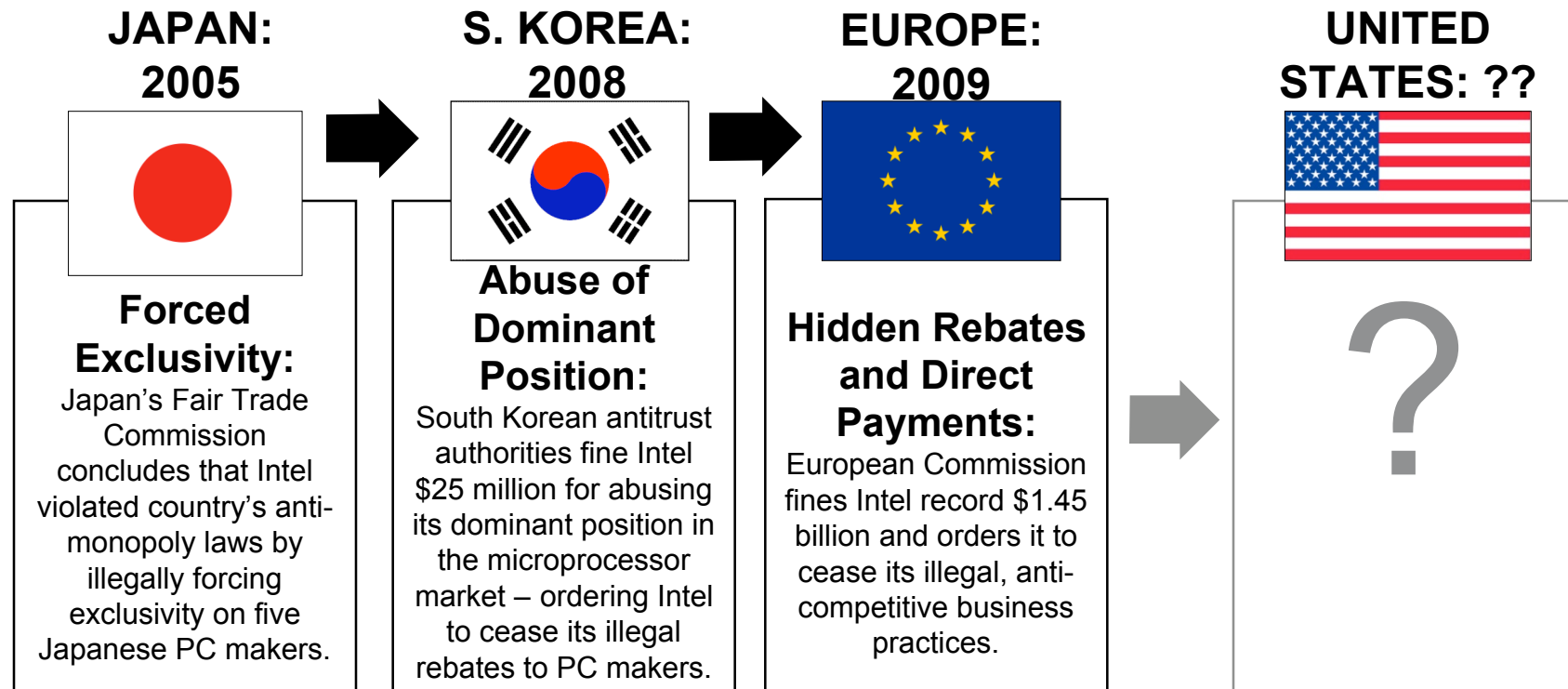


International antitrust watchdogs agree that...
